## THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!

### PARKING

### REGISTRATION & ADMISSION

No advanced registration is required to participate in Homeschool Day. Admission is free for all those participating in the event, just make sure to let our Guest Relations Associate know when you arrive that you are here for Homeschool Day. Tickets for special Homeschool Day programs with limited availability will be distributed on a first-come, first serve basis at ticketing kiosk.

### CHECK-IN

At check-in, you can pick up a schedule of the day's activities and then head into the museum to pick up timed tickets for any special programs with limited availability. Once you have checked in and received a museum sticker, you can come in and out of the museum all day. *Homeschool groups and families receive free museum admission all day, however, special Homeschool Day programming is only scheduled between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm.*

### LUNCH & SNACKS

Unfortunately, there is no lunch storage inside the museum. You may bring a lunch safely secured in a backpack; however, we ask that all food (except water and baby formula) be consumed outside. We invite you to picnic in Hancock Park or on the picnic benches in front of the museum.
