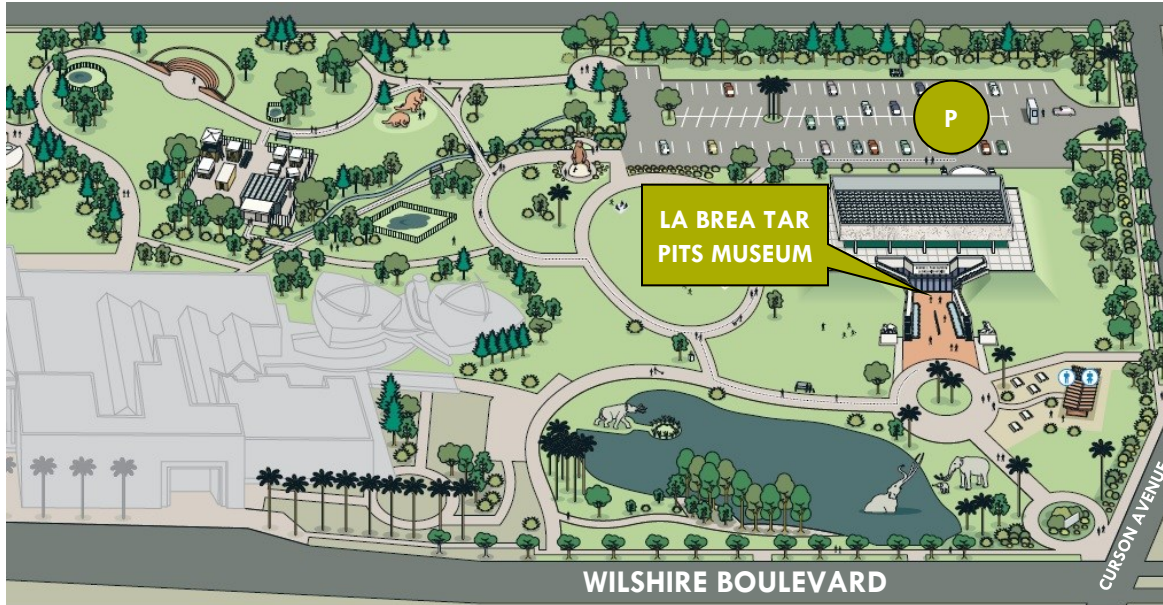


THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!

PARKING

REGISTRATION & ADMISSION

No prior registration or proof of accreditation is required to participate in Homeschool Day! All homeschool networks, families, and organizations are welcome to join us with no minimum number of students or chaperones. Admission is free for all those participating in the event. Tickets for special Homeschool Day programs with limited availability will be distributed on a first-come, first serve basis at check-in. CHECK-IN

Enter the museum through the main doors and check in with School Programs staff inside. At check-in, you can pick up a schedule of the day's activities and sign up for any special programs with limited availability. Once you have checked in and received a museum sticker, you can come in and out of the museum all day.

Homeschool groups and families receive free museum admission all day, however, special Homeschool Day programming is only scheduled between 9:30 am and 12:00 pm.

LUNCH & SNACK

Unfortunately, there is no lunch storage inside the museum. You may bring a lunch safely secured in a backpack, however, we ask that all food (except water and baby formula) be consumed outside. We invite you to picnic in Hancock Park, or on the picnic benches in front of the museum. You will also notice lots of restaurants right nearby on Wilshire Boulevard.
